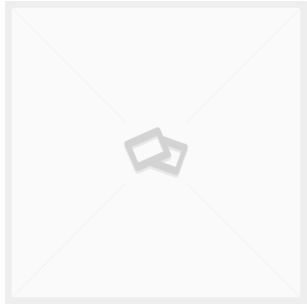

- These limited, high-quality Cognacs are a stellar example of the art of blending.
