

Domaine Buisson-Charles Meursault 1er Cru Les Cras

ABOUT THE ESTATE

- Buisson-Charles is a Meursault estate revered by those in the know and is regarded as a top-tier producer.
- Now in its 4th generation, with the 5th preparing to take over the reins, this is a house steeped in history and tradition.
- Vines are tended organically, and the wines see no chaptalization, acidification, or SO2 added during vinification.
- Picking dates are later than most of their peers, resulting in wines that are richer in style than most while also possessing excellent acidity and tension.
- A connoisseur's delight, the wines of Buisson-Charles are classic Meursault, concentrated, pristine, and complex.

100% Chardonnay

FARMING

Sustainable, Organic, Vegan

SOIL

The upper band has brown / blonde soils, stony, rather steep limestone-clay and early maturity

VINEYARDS & VITICULTURE

From a 0.22 hectare vineyard planted in 1955, located in a sunny lower part of the cru touching Santenots. Vines are trained 1/3 Cordon de Royat and 2/3 Guyot.

HARVEST & VINIFICATION

Pneumatic pressing, then aging for 17 months in Tronçais barrels. 25 to 30% new oak that is medium-toast and rinsed with water in order to limit excessively woody notes in the wine. 17 months of aging and bottling without fining and without filtration.
