





- Domaine Mayard is a new estate in Châteauneuf-du-Pape that also has generations of history.
- Arthur and Hugo Mayard have established their own estate following the separation of the family's vineyards.
- Regenerative agriculture is the focus, with potential longevity of the vines bolstered by organic farming methods and biodiversity.
- The estate comprises about a dozen hectares in several communes in Châteauneuf-du-Pape and Côtes-du-Rhône.
- With six generations of knowledge to rely on, Arthur and Hugo are creating outstanding wines that will contribute to the next chapter of this storied family.

VINEYARDS & VITICULTURE

From lieu-dit le Grand Coulet in Sorgues, lieu-dit la Crau in at the heart of the appellation in the commune of Châteauneuf, and Le Pointu in the Courthezon woods.

HARVEST & VINIFICATION

Grapes are hand harvested, sorted in the vineyard and also in the cellar. Partial destemming, native yeast fermentation and vatting for 4-5 weeks. Aged in concrete tanks and bottled 18 months after harvest.
