

Domaine du Grand Mouton - Louis Métaireau Muscadet Sur Lie Grand Mouton

ABOUT THE ESTATE

- Domaine du Grand Mouton was founded in the mid-20th century by Louis Métaireau, one of a handful of producers responsible for restoring the reputation of the Muscadet appellation.
- Based around the Grand Mouton vineyard, this nine-hectare plot provides vines that were planted as long ago as 1937.
- Vines are tended organically and are situated on two different soil types, both of which bring different characteristics to the wines.
- Aging is done traditionally, on the lees over the winter.
- These wines show the nuance that Muscadet can produce, as each cuvée shows its own distinct personality while still remaining true to their appellation.

VINEYARDS & VITICULTURE

Made from vines over 70 years old. 2nd vineyard to pick at harvest.

HARVEST & VINIFICATION

Hand harvested and uses native yeast to start fermentation. After resting on the lees over the winter in concrete and glass vats, the cuvées are rigorously selected before being bottled in spring. In the spring following each harvest, the wine is siphoned off from above its lees, without stirring or filtering beforehand.
