

## Domaine Morey-Coffinet Chassagne-Montrachet 1er Cru Blanchots Dessus

### ABOUT THE ESTATE

- An estate with serious lineage behind its holdings, Domaine Morey-Coffinet was founded in the late 1970s by Michel and Fabienne Morey, who were succeeded by their son Thibault in 2009.
- With deep roots in the Côte de Beaune, Thibault is well-positioned to continue to take this estate to the next level.
- He has earned the respect of his peers through his thoughtful and detailed approach. In 2014, he began to pursue biodynamic viticulture, and in 2015 gained certification.
- In the cellar, care is taken during vinification and SO2 is kept to a minimum.
- This young winemaker has earned the nickname “the rising star of Chassagne-Montrachet” and leads the way for his generation of vigneron.

### VINEYARDS & VITICULTURE

This minuscule vineyard (0.064 hectare) was formerly known as Montrachet's Feet, as it links the Criots-Montrachet and Montrachet Grand Crus, explaining its strong connection to the Montrachet vineyard before the Grand Cru's current borders were finalized in 1921. Planted in 1981 by Thibault's grandfather Ferdinand Coffinet.

Aged in oak barrels, 35% new. Unfiltered.
