

Domaine Morey-Coffinet Chassagne-Montrachet ler Cru La Romanée



- An estate with serious lineage behind its holdings, Domaine Morey-Coffinet was founded in the late 1970s by Michel and Fabienne Morey, who were succeeded by their son Thibault in 2009.
- With deep roots in the Côte de Beaune, Thibault is well-positioned to continue to take this estate to the next level.
- He has earned the respect of his peers through his thoughtful and detailed approach. In 2014, he began to pursue biodynamic viticulture, and in 2015 gained certification.
- In the cellar, care is taken during vinification and SO2 is kept to a minimum.
- This young winemaker has earned the nickname "the rising star of Chassagne-Montrachet" and leads the way for his generation of vignerons.

VINEYARDS & VITICULTURE

Archaeological findings confirm the ancient village of Chassagne used to be occupied by a Roman society. The Romans planted the vines and built the city, hence the name "Romanée." From a 0.81 hectare parcel of vines planted in 1957 at a higher altitude of Chassagne, protected from the north wind by a stand of trees.

HARVEST & VINIFICATION

Aged 15 months in 228 and 350 L oak barrels, 35% new. Unfiltered.
